2. GrayJay Presentation: Cathy Spencer & Chad Trenholm (from GrayJay)
 - Review Registration for tournaments, development sessions & other opportunities to leverage the platform
 - GrayJay Pay can be leveraged for any type of program (ex: Development, Registration, Team Communications etc...)
 - Teams can be pushed to Hockey Canada Registry
 - Coaching Certification (They haven't built the staff side yet, just players). There are development plans for the coaching side.
 - When a player gets registered for the season into GrayJay, all the contact info (phone, address, email etc.), auto populates to the team when players are assigned to teams. This will save time for coordinators, managers, coaches and EHMHA register.
 - Can be linked to hockey Canada waivers & we can add EHMHA waivers
 - We can add our own questions ex: Do you want to volunteer?
 - We can add policies (Respect Form, Medical Form). We can apply specific policies to specific programs.



- Allows for partial payments, system will notify parents when they need to pay the next installment.
- Credit Card's are not stored in GrayJay. They are processed through Stripe.
- You can add multiple items to the registration ex: Development, Tryout, Registration, Jersey Fee, Rep fee etc... (and they can be optional, ex: you don't need to sign up for development or tryouts)
- You can apply credits to their account (50/50's, jump start)
- For first time players, you can create an HCR account in the program
- Hosted in "Linoed", Canadian Cloud Provider
- Could potentially have an upload function to "import" 50/50 credits
- RIC can use GrayJay to schedule & assign staff
 - All ref's, liney's & timekeepers get invited to platform
 - Once they have their account, you set their qualifications
 - You can then assign them to games in GrayJay
 - Officials specify their availability
 - Mobile App is on the roadmap for future development
 - This is included in base package
 - You can pay the refs through GrayJay or track in GrayJay and pay through alternative means
 - As soon as date or time or venue changes, it removes the refs
 - System can calculate all payments for officials & track payments (not a payroll system). You need to mark that you paid them.
 - HNS uses the system for all referee assignment
